Scanner iPart

This iPart is added to a page on the iMIS Staff site. With this iPart iMIS Staff users can scan member check-in or event attendees using a USB or Bluetooth standard Handheld Barcode Scanner.


The Barcode Scanner can be used for the following two purposes:

Account Verification & Check In

The barcode will be scanned, and the user's ID will be verified against iMIS. If the member is in good standing a message will be displayed and an activity record will be inserted into the iMIS database. The most common scenario for this is a check in desk at a club. The criteria for a member in good standing can be configured through an iMIS IQA

Event Attendance

This option is used to confirm registration at a specific Event and mark attendance. The member's barcode will be scanned and if they have purchased a ticket for the event, a message will show on the screen. They will be marked as attended against the event in iMIS. The email communication listed below is used to generate tickets to an event which are emailed to each registered member

Barcode Ticket iPart

This iPart is placed on a public facing page and generates an online event ticket with Barcode. Each ticket is unique to each user and for a specific iMIS Event. Member can print this ticket or show it on their mobile phone to be scanned at the event entrance. See example screen shot below.


